The purpose of the Office of the Auditor General's Internship Programme is to:-

- Provide a framework by which continuing students from diverse academic backgrounds may be assigned to various directorates and Departments where their educational experience can be enhanced through practical and hands on training in a real work setting.

- Expose students to the various professional disciplines and culture within their areas of specialization.

Requirements to Apply;

- Applications for the January intake should be submitted between 1st October to 30th November of the current Year;
- Applications for the June to August intakes should be submitted between 1st January to 30th April of each calendar Year;
- Period of internship will be for three (3) months;
- Applicants should attach the following documents;
 - ✚ Application/cover letter,
 - ✚ Introductory letter from the university,
 - ✚ Applicants should be in their second (2nd) Year of study.
